



The NYSATA Convention Program Committee has begun to assemble the programming for the 2018 NYSATA Annual Meeting and Clinical Symposia to be held Saturday June 9 at SUNY Cortland.

The NYSATA Convention Program Committee is dedicated to the development of an educational program designed to serve our membership. We are committed to providing an educational experience that will expand the skill sets utilized daily by athletic trainers.

We welcome proposal submissions from NYSATA members and non-members for the following program formats:

General Lecture (1 hour presentation) or

Workshops (typically hands on format; presentation length can be between 1-3 hours)

We are also considering a workshop for 4-5 hours on the morning of Sunday June 10.

All proposals are due for review by February 1, 2018.

### **Proposal Submission Process:**

Proposed topic must fall within one of the five domains of practice for athletic training and must contain content above entry-level.

- Injury and Illness Prevention and Wellness Protection
- Examination, Assessment and Diagnosis
- Immediate and Emergency Care
- Therapeutic Intervention
- Healthcare Administration and Professional Responsibility

### **I. Presentation Information**

- Primary title and sub-headings if appropriate
- Domain of practice for athletic training under which the topic falls
- Three to five keywords that best describe the focus of the presentation
- Abstract (100 words or less) outlining the purpose and content of the presentation
- Level of presentation (Essential, Advanced, Mastery)
- Learning Objectives (at least three)

- Presentation format (i.e. General lecture or Workshop, Sunday Workshop)
- Length of presentation (if workshop format)

- Name & Credentials
- Title or position of speaker
- Affiliation or place of employment
- Contact information: Email, phone
- NATA Membership Status (Member or Non-member)
- CV for uploading (word document or pdf)

## **III. Proposal Deadline**

All proposals are due for review by February 1, 2018; Final decisions will be determined by March 1, 2018.

Presentation must avoid any affiliation with a commercial product or service.

Proposal selection is contingent upon approval by the Convention Program Committee. Incomplete or late applications will not be accepted.
